Member of the Conservative Party, he held the role of Vice President from 2019 to 2020 and as Vice President for the London region from 2017 to 2019, after replacing Stephen Hammond who had withdrawn the conservative whip to rebel to the government on the drawing of the EU withdrawal law. [2] [3] [4] Scully was born in Rugby, Warwickshire on April 29, 1968. The father's family was originally from Burma. He was educated privately at Bedford School of Bedfordshire and the reading university. [5] He moved to London after graduating and managed a series of small businesses. [6] Scully joined the conservative party after the general elections of 1997. Previously he had voted for the referendum party, a Eurosceptic and single-seater political party active in the United Kingdom from 1994 to 1997. [7] Scully political career did not have Success as a conservative candidate in the Wallington South district of London Borough in Sutton in 2002, but was later elected in the Carshalton Central department in 2006. [8] He was the opposition leader to the Sutton Council for three of his four years as Councillor. [9] However, he lost his place to the liberal democratic candidate in the following local elections in 2010. [10] In addition to his work as a local councillor, Scully worked as a parliamentary assistant for conservative deputies Andrew Pelling, Shailesh Vara and Alok Sharma, and established a public relations company called Nudge Factory Ltd in 2011. [11] It was selected as a candidate of the conservative party and subsequently elected as a member of Parliament (MP) for Sutton and Cheam in 2015. [12] and Ā It was re-elected in the general elections of 2017. [13] In September 2017, he was appointed Prime Minister for the trade sent to Brunei, Thailand and Burma and was the private parliamentary secretary in Baronessa Evans, the leader of the Lords House Between November 2017 and January 2018. It is "very proud" of its Burmese heritage. [14] in a parliamentary on 22 October 2015, he"1 am, I believe, the first member of the British parliament to belong to Burmese inheritance." [15] visited myanmar for the first time in February 2016.[16] was active in human rights issues in Burma, especially the situation of Rohingya refugees, and is co-chairman of the interparty parliamentary group for Burma. He wrote of his experience of being one of the first British MPs to visit the Kurtupalong refugee camp during the mass movement of 2017.[17] campaigned for a vote of "Les means Leave" in the 2016 European referendum[18][19] and was a supporter of the campaign group "Less means Leave"[20]. In May 2016, it was reported that scully was part of a series of Conservative MPs investigated by the police during the general elections in the united kingdom of 2015, investigation into party expenses, for having allegedly spent more than the legal limit for electoral campaign expenses.[21] resigned as administrator and corporate secretary of the estate management company brunswick terrace residents association ltd, the same month. in May 2017, the Crown Proclaim Service stated that, although there were evidence of unpredictable returns of expenditure, it did not pass the test for further actions[22]. in June 2017, the comments expressed by scully on the occasion of an electoral campaign and on a regional political program of the bbc regarding the construction of a new sutton hospital were criticized by health activists as an acceptance of the closure of some existing local medical facilities, such as the st helier hospital. scully claimed to be still committed to maintaining the facilities of the st helier hospital, where he had previously volunteered[23]. in October 2017, he was reported as one of the four MPs in office who had commercial interests in lobbying companies, despite the recent attempts [when?] to limit industry access to parliament. After being elected as a deputy, he remained director of the company nudge factory ltd and held 40% of the capital. an article claimed that the customers of the company included real estate companies that develop land within and around its southern london constituency. on October 16, 2017, he resigned as director of the company and emma scully assumed the role of secretary of the company the same day. The article referred to a parliamentary question tabled by scully about the time necessary to put in or or abandoned lands, with an additional question concerning the question of land owned by nbs and targeted by the council of sutton on which to build a biotechnological campus.[24][no primary source needed] the partner in business of scully, ahzaz to the roof chowdh scully denied the charges, answeringto take a salary from the company before being elected and that he had never asked parliamentary questions suggested by the company or its customers.[25] On December 15, 2017, Scully was confirmed as the new Vice-President of the Conservative Party for London, after Stephen Hammond's dismissal two days earlier for not voting with the government on a key to reading. reading.concerning the United Kingdom from the European Union. [26] He helped manage the Conservative Party's campaign in the 2018 London local election, where the party recorded the lowest number of seats in the capital, but made a number of gains on the London Sutton Council. [27] In February 2020, Scully joined the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy as Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State, succeeding Kelly Tolhurst. He was also appointed Minister of London, succeeding Chris Philp. In July 2021. in response to a question about vaccine passports, Scully described himself as a libertarian conservative. [28] On October 22, 2021, Scully spoke of a bill that excluded the practice of dismissing employees and hired them on worse terms and conditions, which led to the bill's failure. Scully said he didn't agree with the intent of the bill, but he didn't think it was the best way to get it. He said: "The unmistakable message is that bully-boy fire-and-shoot tactics, for use as a bargaining tactic, is utterly inappropriate."
